





Iulij Caesaris naturæ virtus, bonarum artium studijs, ac patriæ moribus excitata, hostibus primum necessitate quādam innotuit, mox alijs illustriori significatione per se sp̄lendere cœpit, ac demum indignatione commota in proximos graues offendentes concitauit. animi nanque alacritati usque adeo corpus obediens erat, ut euentus rerum, actaq; prius, quam consilia, et de liberationes eius audirentur. Adolescens admodum L. Sylla inimicitijs ob affinitatem eius neglectam expertus fuga saluti consuluit, cum q; se ab ijs, qui cum fugientem ceperant, pretio redemisset, statim incidit in piratas, à quibus demum pecunia liberatus, in eosdem conuersus omnes ad unum uictos interfecit, quem ad modum per iocum captiuus illis pauloante comminatus fuerat. Hactenus necessitate commota uirtus. Gallias Romano imperio simul octingentis oppidis, ac tercentum populis subactis, adiunxit. quodq; mirum uideri potest, ipse idem, qui fecerat, gesta sua non minus breniter, & eleganter, quam uere, & probate scripsit. eius tandem uis multis elata uictorijs, re pulsarum nescia, acerbis in Cn. Pompeium sacerorum odijs stimulata (ille enim competitor sanè molestius non ciuiliter cum eo de Consulatu contendebat) male animatum in patriam reddidit. Graues igitur inimicitijs persequens in Pharsalia Cn. debellanuit, & irrequieto uictoria cursu Aegypti regem Cleopatra fratrem fugauit, fœmina sola in regno relicta. Inde mira celeritate Pharnacem Mithridatis filium fregit, uictoriā tribus tantum uerbis amicis significans, veni, vidi, vici. Triplex inde triumphus est subsequutus, mox, quia uno die Scipionem, Afranium, Iubamq; Regem præstantissimos belli duces in Lybia superauit, uno mense triumphis quatuor insignitus, uictor, ouansq; patriam reuisit.
